R 7301. RECYCLING REQUIREMENTS

The Superintendent or designee is to ensure that all members of the school community are made aware of the Board's commitment to recycling. Everyone should be aware of what is required to be recycled and where the proper containers are located in the district schools.

Recycling Containers: All recycling containers must be clearly labeled and clearly distinguishable from trash containers. Ideally, recycling signs should be placed directly above recycling containers. The recycling container should be placed NEXT to the trash container. Recycling containers should be placed in all Board property, including the fields owned by the Board.

Annual reporting to the municipality: A tonnage report will be supplied to the municipality reporting the amount of recycling collected in the previous year. The schools will inventory and report to the municipality the number and condition of the recycling containers, labels and signs. An attestation from the Superintendent that the recycling requirements were distributed to the entire school community as stated above.

Principals are encouraged to develop ways to involve students in promotion and participation in the recycling program. This might involved poster competition, special announcements, essay contests, newsletter articles, etc.
