

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR DVRS?

DVRS states...Individuals with a physical, mental, cognitive, or other form of disability that is a substantial impediment to employment may qualify for rehabilitation (VR) services (including students with 504 Plans). The New Commission for the Blind and Visually Impaired (CBVI) provides VR services to individuals who are blind or have a significant visual impairment.”

Students become eligible for DVRS services at the age of 14 and can begin Pre-Employment Transition Services. Case managers typically make the referral to DVRS, but families may do so as well.
