For the whole month of July, 4-H clubs, members, and volunteers will host a variety of activities covering a wide range of interests. "Over the past year, the creative thinking of our 4-H youth members and adult volunteers have resulted in new clubs and new ways to stay connected and engaged in the 4-H program. The activities planned for July are a great way for the public to explore the Morris County area, meet new friends, and have fun!"

July 1st will kick-off the month-long event with Opening Ceremonies and several contests running all month.
